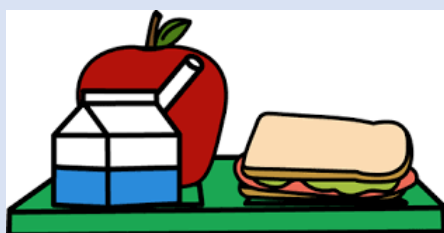
We are starting to plan some summer events so pop them in your diary and we will send more information about them after Easter. Have a great Easter break and we look forward to seeing you all soon.
