## Dealing with disclosure.

**Listen**, but don't question a child if they are telling you about something

**Keep calm**

**DO NOT** ask leading questions or investigate

Let the child know they have done the right thing by telling you

**Support** and **comfort** them

You cannot keep the information secret, so don't tell them you will

Report what you have seen or heard directly to a DSL, who will help you fill in a child protection form



**Whilst in school we ask that visitors switch off their mobile phones and only use them when off site.**
